<input type="checkbox"/>	1	20	Attend a project orientation and start a project portfolio.	Two orientations options are available; one in January of the student's junior year and the other in early September of the student's senior year. Attend one with a parent. If you want the summer to complete work, you must attend the January orientation. Start a project portfolio.
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	30	Get a project topic approved by the project committee.	Carefully select a topic that you really want to learn about. Submit the online topic request form. Obtain a printed/signed copy from the library once it has been approved.
<input type="checkbox"/>	3	200	Get your project activities from 4 different subject areas approved.	Submit 4 Activity Proposal Forms found on the senior project website. Be specific on what you will do and how you plan to prove the work was done. Obtain 4 printed/signed copies once they have been approved.
<input type="checkbox"/>	4	Scored in progress checks	Complete the proposed/accepted project activities.	Do all the activities. Record the time spent in the work journals of the project portfolio. Show printed proof that the work was done in the project portfolio.
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	50	Attend the October progress check (minimum of 2 completed hours).	Students will need to verify that work is being done. Progress check dates will be scheduled through the student's Senior English class. Students must have their portfolio, all forms, up-to-date work journals, and PRINTED PROOF that work was done.
<input type="checkbox"/>	6	50	Attend the January progress check (minimum of 5 completed hours)	Students will need to verify that work is being done. Progress check dates will be scheduled through the student's Senior English class. Students must have their portfolio, all forms, up-to-date work journals, and PROOF that work was done.
<input type="checkbox"/>	7	50	Attend the March progress check (minimum of 10 completed hours)	Students will need to verify that work is being done. Progress check dates will be scheduled through the student's Senior English class. Students must have their portfolio, all forms, up-to-date work journals, and PROOF that work was done.
<input type="checkbox"/>	8	Scored in English class and final portfolio	Successfully complete an Academic Research Paper and a self-reflection assignment.	Most students will do these as part of the English 12 class. The completed documents must be in the project portfolio.
<input type="checkbox"/>	9	400	Turn in the completed project and portfolio.	10 school days prior to the scheduled presentation day, students must turn in their completed project and portfolio to the project supervisors for grading (library).
<input type="checkbox"/>	10	200	Present your project before a board of judges.	Students are to perform a 20 minute formal presentation on the scheduled presentation day to a group of judges.
